Read this user manual carefully before using your digital AM/FM clock radio. To avoid electrical shock or fire, don't expose it to rain or moisture. When adjusting settings, follow only specified procedures to prevent hazardous radiation exposure. A caution marking on the rating plate located at the bottom of the device warns against opening it due to high voltage inside. Keep liquids away and ensure the main plug is always easily accessible. Don't mix old and new batteries, and avoid exposing them to excessive heat or sunlight. Now, let's get started with your clock radio. First, connect the power supply and remove the protective cap from the backup battery. Plug in the power adapter and turn on the device using the power button. Familiarize yourself with all the buttons, then set the clock by pressing and holding the clock button. Use the tuner button to input the correct time, and confirm it by pressing the clock button. To set an alarm, press and hold AL1 or AL2 until it starts blinking, then use the tuner button to select the desired hour, minute, and sound type. Confirm the settings and activate the alarm by pressing AL1 or AL2 twice. You can silence the alarm temporarily using the snooze/dimmer feature, which will resume after 9 minutes. To stop the alarm, press the power button. Finally, learn how to set up your radio by pressing the power button to turn it on, then hold the program button for automatic scanning and saving of favorite stations to memory. Alternatively, you can manually scan stations using the tuner button and save them to memory using the memory/sleep button. 90 mins, 60, 30, 15 & 00 to turn off sleep timer. In such cases, remove the disc and let the unit sit in a warm place for several hours until the moisture evaporates. Insert battery into designated slot, ensuring positive and negative terminals align with corresponding symbols. Close battery compartment door and insert two AA-batteries for optimal backup power functionality during power outages. Battery supplies power to maintain clock time and alarm memory, but display turns off and other features are disabled. Check battery condition by unplugging and replugging AC adapter; replace if displayed time is incorrect.
